

INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE OF BIBLE THEOLOGY ACCREDITATION

International College of Bible Theology is accredited with Accrediting Commission International. We are not accredited with a large regional association. However, we have filed with the Library of Congress in Washington, D.C. We have not applied for federal grants, but our students can receive Veteran's benefits. Accreditation is not granted by the State Educational System. It is a separate affiliation.

Concerning the transfer of credits, this is based upon individual college criteria. Education at college level is highly competitive including those colleges within the religious community. There seems to be various requirements among the numerous denominations. Most Liberal Arts colleges accept only certain courses taken at a Bible college. ICBT is inter-denominational and accepts transfers from most colleges. The number of credits accepted depends on the program a student is enrolling in. We have not had complaints from ICBT students concerning the transfer of credits.

As stated before, we are purely a theological school. We are not a member of any regional accrediting body; however, we are a member of the Accrediting Commission International for Schools, Colleges and Theological Seminaries, as noted in the Library of Congress (TX1-191-576).
